During our recent visit to the UK, we visited the local garden centre for lunch, which was great! However, our route to the restaurant was lengthy, and convoluted, as we were manoeuvred through display after display of items for xmas decorations. I refuse to use the word Christmas in that context, feeling closer to Ebeneezer Scrooge than our Lord and Saviour! Even caught myself muttering Bah! Humbug!! Scrooge exists in opposition to the very idea of Christmas. He values business, wealth, and solitude, while Christmas is about community, charity, and family.

This begs the question who are my family?

Try this from Matthew 12:46-50 NIV:

While Jesus was still talking to the crowd, his mother and brothers stood outside, wanting to speak to him. Someone told him, "Your mother and brothers are standing outside, wanting to speak to you." He replied to him, "Who is my mother, and who are my brothers?" Pointing to his disciples, he said, "Here are my mother and my brothers. For whoever does the will of my Father in heaven is my brother and sister and mother."

Or this from John 13:34 ESV:

A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another: just as I have loved you, you also are to love one another.

Or this from Matthew 25:40 NIV

The King will reply, 'Truly I tell you, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did for me.'

I know there are many more quotations that also fit with the season and the sentiment, I'm sure you will have fun trying to find them

I have always been very proud of the All Saints Vendée contribution to Restos du Coeur, and Martin and I support them as much and as often as we can. I have also discovered that Restos are not only concerned with food distribution, though that is very important. Les Restos du Cœur is the story of a "little idea" that became a national symbol. In 1985, on Europe 1 radio, Michel Coluche mobilized the country's goodwill around a project for a free soup kitchen for people in need. Four decades later, Les Restos has 75,000 volunteers and continues to fight against poverty and all forms of inequality. The organization has grown, but its needs and the social emergency have never been greater. It is suggested that the proceeds of the quiz in November this year go to them, and I wholeheartedly agree.

So we approach the time when we celebrate the birth of our Lord Jesus I wish you all a very blessed and peace filled Christmas, and share with you the prayer I'll be using every day until Christmas:

Dear Lord, how we praise and thank You that love in the person of the Lord Jesus Christ came down at Christmas, when the eternal Son of God became Jesus, the perfect Son of Man, and through whom the promise of peace was given to men of goodwill. Peace with God to those who trust in the redeeming blood of His Son, and the peace of God, for all who are born into the family of God, positioned in Christ and accepted in the Beloved.

Thank You, for the example of a life that personifies love and thank You that the Person of Jesus Christ is the One that satisfies every need of the human heart.

Father, at this special time of the year when we remember that first Christmas day when Your dearly beloved Son was manifested in the flesh in the form of a new-born babe, we pray that His love and His peace may spread abroad into the hearts and minds of many lost and hurting people, who feel themselves unloved and who lack that vital peace with God and the incomparable peace of God within, that surpasses all comprehension.

May the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit grant peace in the hearts of all who are searching for answers, as to emptiness in their lives, this Christmas time. We ask this in the name of Jesus, Amen.
