Firstly, allow me to express my deep appreciation of the love and care shown by ASV members to Martin and I, during our recent medical hiatus'. We were truly uplifted and heartened and cherished by the many messages we have received. Martin is now being treated for Sleep Apnoea and learning to use a pressure mask at night. I'm making slow progress, very frustratingly slow, but getting there. I still have some discomfort, but I'm happy to say that the level of pain is much reduced, and God willing, will disappear over time. Thank you to you all.

We're now entering the time in the Church's calendar known as Lent. 46 days, (Sundays included), of preparation for Easter, and the death and resurrection of our Lord.

Lent is meant to be a time of repentance. These 40 days are set aside to praise and worship the Lord; to read the Bible more, and to pray more often. Or is it really just a time of giving up chocolate or social media?

As many Christians mark the beginning of Lent this year on Wednesday, March 5th, known as Ash Wednesday, it's important to remember that primary purpose of Lent is a time of repentance. That's not a feeling of shame but an awareness that sin separates us from God and what Christ endured to save us from sin, death, and the devil. "Shame has its place, but feeling shame over sin is not the same thing as repentance from sin" because "our tempter can take our obedience to God and turn it into a source of pride." Lent should always lead us toward gratitude for Jesus' sacrifice on Good Friday and his resurrection on Easter.

I recently preached about making oneself available to God for His work, using the old catch phrase "I'm Free!" Lent is a great time to reflect on that; are you "Free" to serve God??

Soon we shall be holding our AGM, and will need to elect one new Warden and a Secretary for the Chaplaincy council. We will also need new council members. But, there are many other ways in which you can offer your commitment! Worship Leading, Eucharistic assistants, Sidespeople, members of the prayer chain, and so on. Please use this Lenten period to seek God's will for your lives, look for ways in which you can offer the skills you have in service to God through All Saints. Give thanks to God for the gift of Jesus, seek how to serve others in His name and for His glory!

Complete renewal of the Electoral Roll

Every six years all churches in The Church of England are required to prepare a completely new Electoral Roll and the old Roll is redundant. This year is one such year on the six year cycle and so, as Electoral Roll Officer, I will be preparing this new Roll to take effect at the Church Annual Meeting (AGM) which will be on Sunday, May 11th 2025. The Church Representation Rules state that the Roll "must be completed at least 15 days, but no more than 28 days, before the annual church meeting" so I will be closing the roll between the 13th and 26th April. Every person who wishes to have his or her name entered on the new Roll, whether it is entered on the present Roll or not, is requested to apply for enrolment before 13th April and new forms will be available shortly.

Being on the Electoral Roll entitles you to attend and vote at the Annual Meeting and to stand for election to the Church Council. Please contact me if you need any further information.

We have a positive balance for the month: + 401.30 €

Although our monthly income was down, our expenditure was also lower, giving us a balance of about $500 \in \text{lower}$ than this time last year.
